

Directions to PACSGEAR

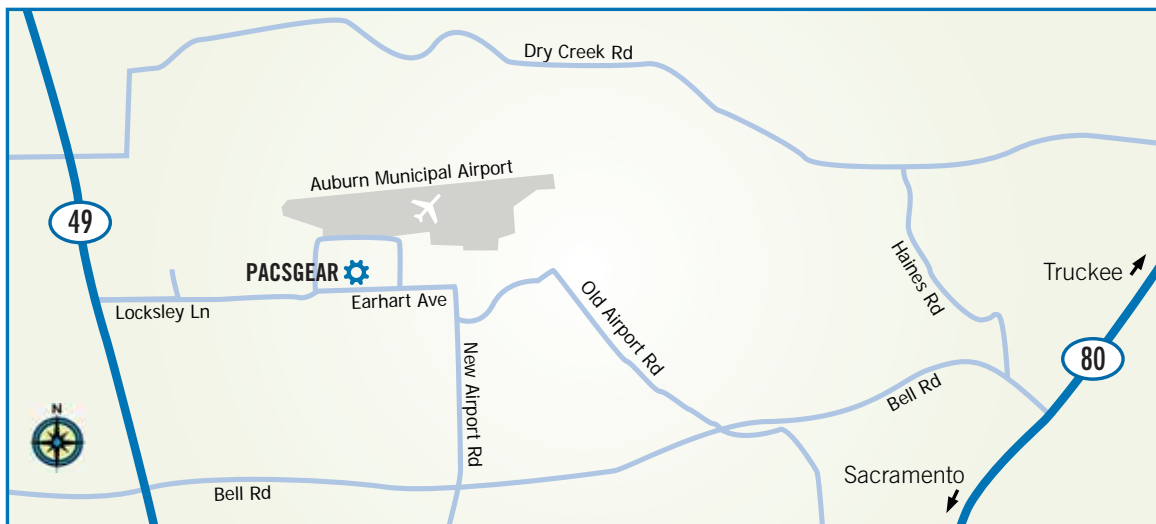


The **PACSGEAR** Auburn, California office is located near the junction of highway 80 and highway 49 in the Sierra foothills. It is approximately 45 miles northeast of Sacramento International Airport, 135 miles northeast of San Francisco International Airport and 130 miles northeast of PACSGEAR's corporate office in Pleasanton.

From Sacramento International Airport

- ✦ **Driving directions:** Follow Airport Exit signs to I-5 S and take the ramp onto I-5 S. Approximately 6 miles later, take Exit 522 to merge onto I-80 East toward Reno. Travel on I-80 East for approximately 37 miles and take Exit 123 for Bell Road. Turn left at Bell Road. Approximately 2 miles down the hill, turn right at New Airport Road. Take the first left onto Earhart Avenue. PACSGEAR will be on your right.



From San Francisco International Airport

- ⚙️ **Driving directions:** Follow Airport Exit signs to US-101 North. Approximately 11 miles later, take a slight right at I-80 East (follow the signs for Bay Bridge/Oakland). Continue over the bridge and on I-80 for approximately 122 miles and take Exit 123 for Bell Road. Turn left at Bell Road. Approximately 2 miles down the hill, turn right at New Airport Road. Take the first left onto Earhart Avenue. PACSGEAR will be on your right.

From PACSGEAR's Pleasanton office (toll road)

- ⚙️ **Driving directions:** Turn right at Hacienda Drive and continue north to I-580 W. Take the ramp onto I-580 W toward Oakland. In approximately 2 miles merge onto I-680 N toward Sacramento. After approximately 45 miles, merge onto I-80 E and continue for an additional 81 miles. Take Exit 123 for Bell Road and turn left at Bell Road. Approximately 2 miles down the hill, turn right at New Airport Road. Take the first left onto Earhart Avenue. PACSGEAR will be on your right.
