

Directions to PACSGEAR



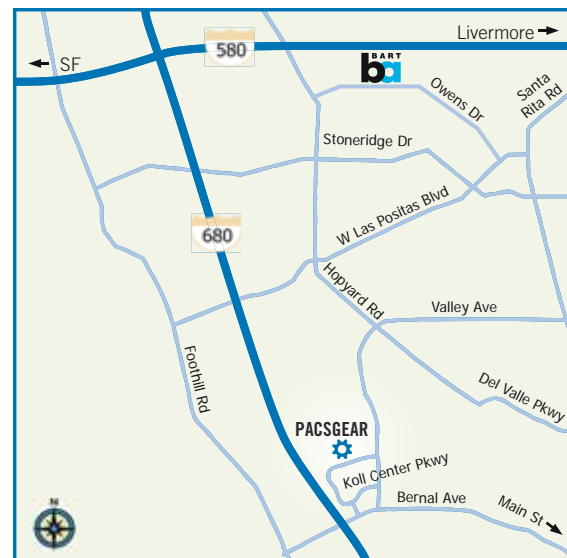
PACSGEAR is located near the junction of I-580 and I-680 in Pleasanton, California, approximately 20 miles East of Oakland International Airport, 30 miles North of San Jose International Airport, and 40 miles East of San Francisco International Airport.

From Oakland International Airport (from the West)

⚙️ **Driving directions:** Follow Airport Exit signs and take 98th Avenue to I-880 S toward San Jose. Travel on I-880 S and approximately 3 miles later merge onto I-238 S via the I-580 / I-238 exit to Castro Valley / Stockton. Three miles later, I-238 becomes I-580 E. Continue on I-580 E for another 10 miles to I-680 and then take the right fork to the I-680 S exit toward San Jose. Travel approximately 3 miles and exit at Bernal Avenue toward Pleasanton. Turn left at Koll Center Drive and another left at Koll Center Parkway. PACSGEAR is located in the “North Creek I” complex. Turn left at the “North Creek I” sign and another left to Suite 100, which is located on the side of the building.

⚙️ **BART directions:** At OAK, take the AirBART bus to the Coliseum / Oakland Airport BART station. Board a Dublin / Pleasanton train and travel approximately 30 minutes to the end of the line (Dublin / Pleasanton station). Our office is a ten minute ride by taxi from the BART station. From San Jose International Airport (from the South)

- ⚙️ **Driving directions:** Follow Airport Exit signs to US-101 S toward Los Angeles for about 1 mile to I-880 N. Take I-880 N toward Oakland. Approximately 8 miles later, merge onto Mission Boulevard via the Mission Boulevard / I-680 exit to Sacramento. Cross under I-680 and take the ramp onto I-680 N toward Sacramento. Travel approximately 14 miles and exit at Bernal Avenue toward Pleasanton. Turn left at Koll Center Drive and another left at Koll Center Parkway. PACSGEAR is located in the “North Creek I” complex. Turn left at the “North Creek I” sign and another left to Suite 100, which is located on the side of the building.

From San Francisco International Airport (from the Peninsula)

- ⚙️ **Driving directions:** Follow Airport Exit signs to US-101 S toward San Jose for about 7 miles to CA-92. At the CA-92 exit, take the left fork to CA-92 E / Hayward and cross the San Francisco Bay on the San Mateo Bridge (free direction). Take the I-880 N exit toward Oakland. Travel on I-880 N and approximately 4 miles later merge onto I-238 S via the I-580 / I-238 exit to Castro Valley / Stockton. Three miles later, I-238 becomes I-580 E. Continue on I-580 E for another 10 miles to I-680 and then take the right fork to the I-680 S exit toward San Jose. Travel approximately 3 miles and exit at Bernal Avenue toward Pleasanton. Turn left at Koll Center Drive and another left at Koll Center Parkway. PACSGEAR is located in the “North Creek I” complex. Turn left at the “North Creek I” sign and another left to Suite 100, which is located on the side of the building.
- ⚙️ **BART directions:** At SFO, take the AirTrain to the airport BART station. Travel approximately 1 hour and 30 minutes to the end of the Dublin / Pleasanton line. Our office is a ten minute ride by taxi from the BART station. For more information, visit www.bart.gov.

From the East or North

- ⚙️ **Driving directions:** Take I-580 W to I-680 S toward San Jose. Travel approximately 3 miles and exit at Bernal Avenue toward Pleasanton. Turn left at Koll Center Drive and another left at Koll Center Parkway. PACSGEAR is located in the “North Creek I” complex. Turn left at the “North Creek I” sign and another left to Suite 100, which is located on the side of the building.
